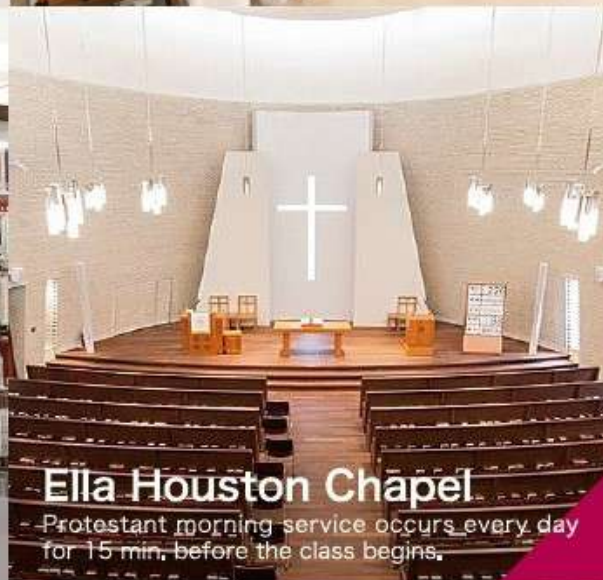

Courses

Curriculums can be designed freely according to students' interests and Japanese language skills by selecting courses regularly offered by departments in addition to the general education (GE) courses and special courses for international students.

General Education Courses
