KOREA UNIVERSITY

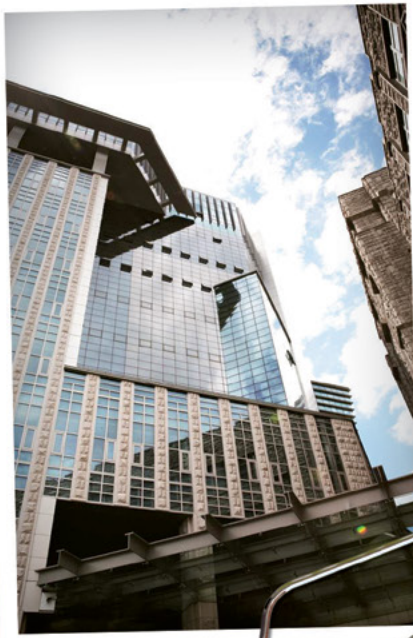
- Established in 1905, Korea University is a member of the prestigious group of SKY universities in Korea, similar to the Ivy League in the U.S.

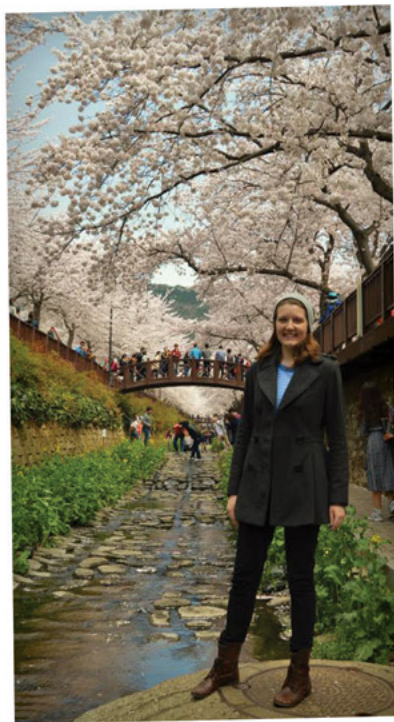

Known for its incredible beaches, rugged mountain ranges and historic temples, Busan (pronounced as pu-san) offers a one-of-a-kind combination of a comfortable climate, historic culture and fun entertainment. Though it's the second-largest city in South Korea, Busan maintains a chill beachside atmosphere complete with plenty of cool bars, small boutiques, trendy cafes and sensational seafood. The urban hub is on the coast and dissected by mountains making it just as tempting to nature lovers as city slickers.

PUSAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY

- Pusan National University (PNU) is one of South Korea's leading research universities and particularly well known for business and global studies.
- It's ranked as one of the Top 10 universities in South Korea and Top 100 universities in Asia, according to the 2019 QS World University Rankings.
- The public university is fringed by mountains and offers a small college town feel on-campus, complete with its own shuttle bus.

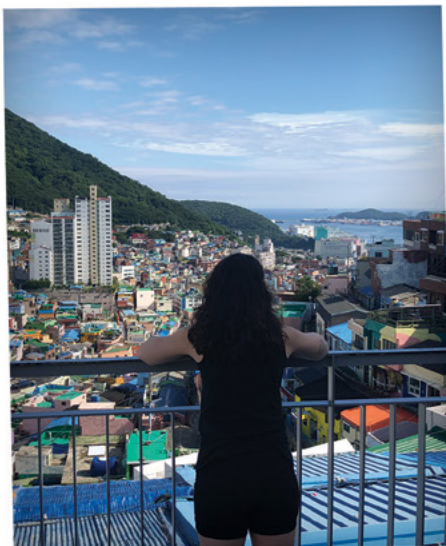
